  - 3. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representative and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS *SKIDMORE COLLEGE*, its officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessor of the premises used to conduct the event ("Release"), WITH RESPECT TO AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by the law.

## BIKEMORE Campus Bike Share Program Sustainability Office

## Please read carefully and initial each box!!!

	I am 18 years of age or older.
	Bicycles must be returned within <b>8 hours</b> to the <b>corresponding lockbox</b> . The racks will be inspected daily, and failure to return the bike to its designated location upon returning will be recorded. Individuals who do not return bicycles properly will lose the privilege of the campus bike share program.
	Riders must check bicycle for any damage or necessary maintenance before using a bicycle. All riders are obligated to email a Bike Damage Report to <a href="mailto:bikemore@skidmore.edu">bikemore@skidmore.edu</a> if any problems occur while riding BikeMore bicycles, or if any damage or maintenance issues are found while inspecting bicycles.
	Do not have more than one bike checked out at a time.
	Do not repeatedly check bikes out for extended amounts of time. Use the bicycles when you need them, they are not intended to be your personal bike. Your activity will be assessed accordingly.
	Bicycle program privileges may be revoked for unsafe or rude conduct or failure to obey instructions.
	Bicycle equipment is intended for riding on paved roadways only, do not use in woods or off-road terrain.
	Full responsibility is assumed if the bicycle or other equipment is damaged or stolen while in my possession. I will be held accountable for the replacement/repair cost of:  • \$800.00- Bicycle  • \$15.00 - Key  • Other damages will be assessed and charged on a case by case basis
	Bicycle helmets are not required by law, but are highly recommended, and students should understand that they assume any additional risks by not wearing one. Helmets can be checked out by visiting the Campus Safety Office.
	Riders are expected to understand hazards posed by other bicycles, traffic or road conditions and observe all traffic laws, follow safe procedures and to avoid unnecessary, hazardous situations.
	Riders should understand that there are risks involved in cycling and that serious injuries are a possible occurrence.
	Riders are responsible for any damage(s) to pedestrians, property or automobiles caused while operating bicycles.
	Riders must be in proper physical condition to cycle and agree that Skidmore College has no obligation to provide a physical examination to evidence their fitness.
	PINs are unique to your account only. DO NOT give your PIN to others as you will be charged for any loss or damage incurred while a bicycle is checked out under your PIN.
